### 1) HUMBER VALLEY CHALETS

The Humber Valley Chalets are part of a spectacular resort that is located about 10-15 minutes east of Corner Brook. The chalets are very much luxury accommodations ranging from 3, 4 and 5 bedroom chalets. Each chalet has generous modern kitchens, spacious living and dining areas, sizeable bedrooms with en-suite bathrooms often featuring whirlpool baths and massage showers. Each bedroom has a queen or king sized bed that can comfortably sleep 2 people.

**Each chalet that a team books will require 1-2 chaperones staying with the players, therefore we are confident 2-3 chalets would more than suffice any team (depending of course on the size of your roster, # of chaperones you bring, and if you book a 3, 4, or 5 bedroom chalet).**

Although this option may be a little more expensive than your average hotel, overall we feel the value for what you are getting is absolutely tremendous. Also, with full kitchens in the chalets, teams can prepare their own meals and save money dining at restaurants. There would be a tremendous amount of space within the chalets and also outdoors on the resort that certainly beats a hotel room. The NLSA has had teams stay at the Humber Valley in the past and it has been an excellent experience for everyone.
